Re: Youth Conference Registration Forms

Dear Youth Leaders,

We are looking forward to our up-coming Youth Conference being held at Troy University July 12-14, 2007. Enclosed are the registration forms for this conference.

In an effort to meet the needs of each participant and to help the registration process go as smoothly as possible, we are asking that each Stake assign a Registration Advisor to distribute, review, and return all registration forms and correspondence.

The Stake Youth Conference Registration Advisor should do the following:

1. See that the youth registration forms are distributed to each eligible youth as soon as possible. Youth should receive the "Youth Registration, Health Information and Parental Consent Form," "Code of Conduct and Dress Standards," and "Items to Bring." Each Ward/Branch should make a copy of the completed Youth Registration, Health Information and Parental Consent Forms for their records and for use during travel.
2. See that the adult registration forms are distributed to all chaperones and adults (including Bishops and Branch Presidents) that will be attending the conference. Adults should receive the "Adult Registration Form," "Code of Conduct and Dress Standards," "Chaperone Guidelines," and "Items to Bring."
3. See that the "Roommate Assignments" form is distributed to Bishops/Branch Presidents. Worthiness interviews of youth and chaperones should be conducted at the Bishop's/Branch President's discretion. The "Roommate Assignments" form may be useful in keeping track of youth conference participants from their unit (including friends or extended family of youth that may ask to attend). Please use the comments section of this form to indicate any youth who may need to be assigned to the same youth conference activity group (such as a non-member friend or a youth with special needs who may need assistance) or any youth or adult with special housing needs (i.e. difficulty climbing stairs, etc.).
4. Collect all completed registration forms from each unit with the accompanying Roommate Assignments form. Please review the forms to be sure that each

has been signed by the participant and parent/guardian and that each youth is listed on the Roommate Assignments form. Keep a copy of these forms for your own records.

5. **Return all forms no later than June 1, 2007 to:**
